
SAFETY, HEALTH & ENVIRONMENT TECHNICIAN LEVEL 3





Health, Safety and Environmental (SHE)
Technician's will work with the organisation to advise on the statutory health, safety and environmental requirements they are expected to meet. They will assist in ensuring that the legal and company SHE requirements are implemented. SHE Technician's will assist to develop, review and check on the implementation of safe systems of work, deliver training, investigate incidents, analyse data and present findings to the management team. This course directly maps to the delivery of ISO 45001 and 14001 health, safety and environmental standards.

- Delivering SHE training
- Development, management, implementation and monitoring of the Safety, Health and Environmental Management System
- SHE policies and processes applying generic industry guidance

HOW IS IT FUNDED?

Levy paying: if your levy account has the funds to cover the full apprenticeship cost then the cost will be drawn down from your levy account each month for the duration of the apprenticeship.

Non-levy-paying companies: employers will pay 5% towards the cost of the apprenticeship and the Government will pay the remaining 95%, up to the funding band maximum. The 5% contribution will be required after the initial enrolment is completed and will be billed in full.
